- Ensuring the Pupil Premium Grant is being spent appropriately by the school for the benefit of our "vulnerable groups" of children and assessing what impact this has on their outcomes.

Specific activities over the last few months have included:

- Working on the budget which allowed the smooth transition to the new building and continues to endeavour to meet the increasing needs of new pupils joining the school and providing them with appropriate staffing support.
- Monitoring the implementation of the school curriculum, how targets are being set for the pupils and how progress is being assessed.
- Monitoring how career and work-experience opportunities are developed for our pupils
- Taking a close interest in how the mental health of pupilsand staff is supported and managed

Membership of the Governing Body evolved during the year. Shirley Croft continued as Chair of Governors, retaining David Burrows as Vice Chair. Rachel Burrage, Lucy Lavender, Julia Deery and Gareth Mitchell remain with us as co-opted Governors and are now joined by Scott Bradley as our Local Authority Governor and Georgia Hall as a new co-opted Governor. Vicki Stevens and Lucy Smith are our Parent Governors. Marie Saunders remains as our Staff Governor. We were sorry to say goodbye to Sharon Stoker who had been a Governor for many years.
